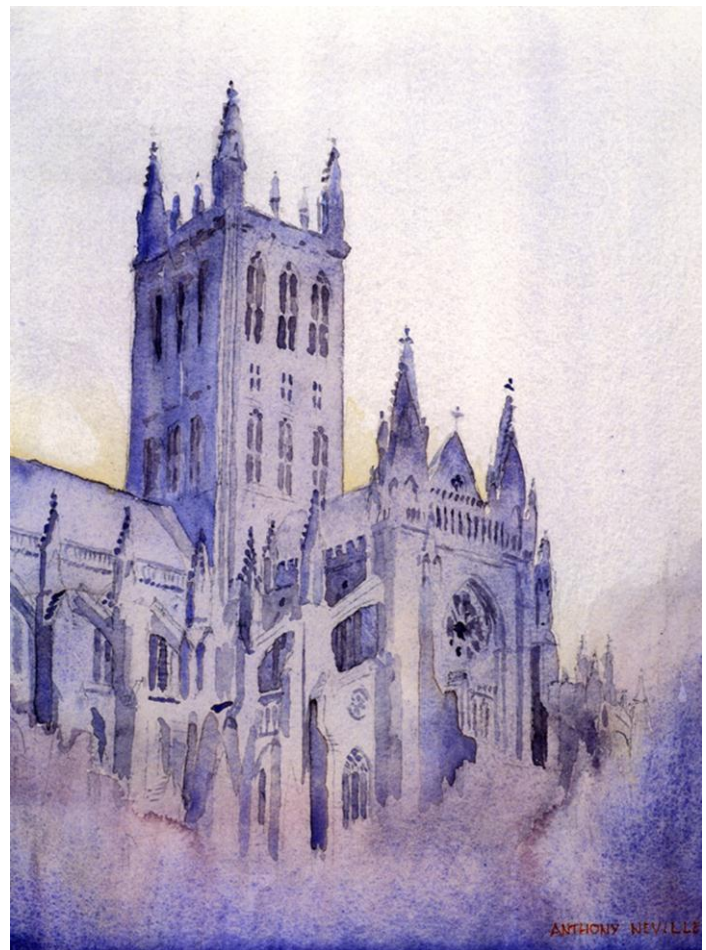

Pickup will be **Monday, Nov. 7, from 11-12 a.m.**

The MCC will not allow sales at the Center, so you do not need to include price information. Miniatures are welcome but this show is not limited to miniatures. If you have a small picture stand to hold your work, please bring that too. At the October 28th general meeting, members will vote to determine first, second, and third place winners for this small works show. There is no prize money, but winners can enjoy a brief moment of fame. Winners will be posted on the MAS website.

If your dues are not paid up for the 2010-11 year, include an additional \$40 with your entry fee. Make checks to McLean Art Society, c/o Vicky Wilken, 1448 Colleen Lane, McLean, VA 22101.

Entries must be the artist's original work and not previously entered in a MAS juried show. Size, including frame, is not to exceed 40 inches in any direction. A card must be attached on the back of the work listing Name, Title and Price. No saw tooth hangers. The McLean Project for the Arts will charge a 25% commission on any work sold.

By signing this agreement you agree that McLean Art Society and its members will not be held responsible for any loss or damage and that you agree to the rules of the show as presented in this prospectus.
